GWC-Led Services Privacy Policy Highlights

We believe you should always know what data we collect from you, how we use it, and that you should have meaningful control over both. We want to empower users to make the best decisions about the information that they share with us.

This Privacy Policy applies to the Girls Who Code GWC-Led Services (defined below) and does not apply to the Girls Who Code Clubs Services that we offer at <https://clubs-hq.girlswhocode.com> in connection with community center or school use (the “GWC Clubs HQ”)(“Clubs Services”) or our informational website located at www.girlswhocode.com (“GWC Website”).

You should read this policy in [full](#), but here are a few key points:

- **Personal Information We Collect:** Please see [this page](#) where we detail the [Personal Information](#) we collect from each user type, including the sources from which the information was collected, the business purpose for which the information was collected, and the third parties with whom we share or disclose Personal Information for a business purpose. You can also find more details [below](#).

We also have an [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#) that outlines our use of cookies and pixels for GWC-Led Services.

- **How We Use the Information We Collect:** We use the Personal Information we collect from or about individuals who are engaging with the GWC provided services, including our Summer programming, our College and Career programming (like College Loops), and our GWC Community, Events, Contests, and Special Opportunities. (“GWC-Led Service Users”) to provide and improve the services (including for security and safety purposes, or as allowed by law). You can also find more details [below](#).
- **Data Retention:** We store GWC-Led Service Users Personal Information in accordance with legal requirements and for as long as it is necessary to provide products and Services to you and others. Personal Information associated with your account will be kept until your account is deleted or until we no longer need the information to provide the Service, whichever occurs first. Additionally, some information is deleted or anonymized after a set period of time. For additional information on our retention periods, see [here](#).
- **Children (Under 13 years of age).** GWC GWC-Led Services are not directed or available to Children (individuals under the age of thirteen (13)) ([see here for more details](#)). No Children’s information is made available or visible to the general public through GWC, and no Children’s information is used for [behavioral targeting](#) or [Third Party advertising](#). See our [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#) for more information.
- **We Never Sell Personal Information:** We will never [Sell](#) or rent your Personal Information or non-personal information. We will only disclose Personal Information as set forth in this Privacy Policy, such as with a limited set of [Third Party Service Providers](#) necessary to provide

or develop our services (such as database hosting) or as required by law, and we will be transparent about who these service providers are.

We will contractually require that these Third Party Service Providers process Personal Information in accordance with our instructions and consistent with this Privacy Policy. We ensure that these Third Party Service Providers employ reasonable and comprehensive data protection and security protocols. See [here](#) for more details.

- **You own your data:** We don't own any content or information you provide or we receive - you will own your content and information.
- **Security and Privacy by Design and Default:** We use security industry best practices to protect Personal Information, including using encryption and other security safeguards to protect Personal Information. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

Girls Who Code's mission is to close the gender gap in technology and to change the image of what a programmer looks like and does.

Keeping this trust through your privacy and safety is incredibly important to us.

This Privacy Policy explains:

- What information GWC collects from you (and why we collect it),
- How we use and share that information,
- The choices and rights you have, including how to access, update, delete your information, and take your information out of Girls Who Code.

We will only collect, use, and share your [Personal Information](#) in accordance with this Privacy Policy. This policy applies whether you login to use Girls Who Code through <https://hq@girlswhocode.com> (the "[GWC HQ](#)"), or any services or products that link to this Privacy Policy that Girls Who Code, Inc. ("GWC", "we", "us", "our", and our subsidiaries or affiliates) may provide now or in the future (collectively, the "[GWC-Led Services](#)"). This Privacy Policy also covers GWC's treatment of any Personal Information about our users that our partners or other services share with us, for example, responses to a User survey collected through [Alchemer](#).

This Privacy Policy applies solely to the GWC-Led Services and does not apply Girls Who Code Clubs Services, which we offer in connection with community center or school use (located at <https://clubs-hq.girlswhocode.com>) (the "[GWC Clubs HQ](#)") nor does it apply to any other Girls Who Code Clubs Services or products offered by GWC ("[Clubs Services](#)"). The GWC Clubs Privacy Policy can be found [here](#). This Privacy Policy also does not apply to our informational website located at www.girlswhocode.com ("[GWC Website](#)"). You can find the GWC Website Privacy Policy [here](#).

This Privacy Policy also does not apply to information collected through other websites, products, or services that GWC doesn't own or control, such as Third Party services you might access through links or other features (e.g., social media buttons, any GWC-Led Service [Third Party Platform Providers](#) (as shared [below](#)) email campaigns, push or in-app notifications, or YouTube videos) on the [GWC-Led Services](#). These other services have their own privacy policies, and we encourage you to review them before providing them with Personal Information.

GWC may be acting as both a [Controller](#) and a Processor as those terms are defined under the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation, including as implemented or adopted under the laws of the United Kingdom ("GDPR"), or as defined under any other applicable state privacy law in the United States. Our Privacy Policy is designed to provide transparency into our privacy practices and principles. Protecting your privacy is incredibly important to us. This Privacy Policy is here to help you understand how we treat any [Personal Information](#) that you share with us when you use the GWC [GWC-Led Services](#). This Privacy Policy applies solely to the GWC-Led Services and does not apply to the GWC Clubs program or Products - you can find the GWC Clubs Privacy Policy [here](#). Other companies that GWC doesn't own or control will have their own privacy policies, and you should read them, too!

ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND CONSENT

By using the [GWC-Led Services](#), you acknowledge that you accept and agree to this Privacy Policy. By visiting [GWC HQ](#), or using our GWC-Led Services in any manner, you acknowledge that you accept the terms, practices and policies described in this Privacy Policy (and as updated from time to time), and you hereby agree that we may collect, use, and share your information as described herein. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, you should not use our GWC-Led Services. Your use of our GWC-Led Services is at all times subject to our [Terms of Service](#) (as updated from time to time (the "Terms")), which incorporates this Privacy Policy. Any capitalized terms we use in this Privacy Policy without defining them have the definitions given to them in the Terms.

Basically,

By visiting our [GWC HQ](#) platform or using our [GWC-Led Services](#), you agree that we may collect, use and share your information as described in our Privacy Policy.

WHAT ARE THE GWC GWC-LED SERVICES?

GWC's [GWC-Led Services](#) encompass several different services, including our summer programming, our College and Career programming (like College Loops), and our GWC Community, Events, Contests, and Special Opportunities.

While GWC-Led Services includes a number of different programs and activities, GWC-Led Service Users generally fall into one of the following categories:

[Program Applicants](#) are individuals who are applying to certain types of GWC Led Services (ex. Pathways). [Event Registrants](#) are individuals who sign up to attend a GWC-Led Service (ex. Events). [Program Participants](#) are those GWC-Led Service Users who participate in an GWC-Led Service, regardless of whether they had to apply to the opportunity, register for the opportunity, or simply attend an open to the public activity. [Community Partners](#) include third parties who partner with GWC to support GWC-Led Services, including, among others, third-party organizations, Research Partners, and grantors. Community Partner employees or volunteers, and certain GWC-Led Services Users in leadership roles for a GWC-Led Services (Ex. College Loop Presidents), are considered [Program Volunteers](#). [Focus Group/Survey Participants](#) are GWC-Led Service Users who participate in feedback sessions with [GWC Personnel](#) or Community Partners.

[GWC-Led Service Users](#) consist of any individual using the GWC-Led Services. [GWC-Led Service Minor Users](#) are individuals between the ages of 13-17. For activities that involve GWC-Led Service Minor Users, parental consent is collected where required (ex. Pathways). Different GWC-Led Service have different consent requirements. To learn more about these, and the GWC-Led Services in general, see our GWC-Led Services FAQ [here](#).

GWC-Led Services and the GWC HQ Platform

The GWC-Led Services may utilize the GWC platform, ("[GWC HQ](#)"), a web application with lightweight learning management tools connected to our custom curriculum resources, facilitation guides, and our GWC [Integrated Development Environment \("IDE"\)](#). GWC-Led Service Users and [GWC-Led Services Minor Users](#) may be prompted to create an account on GWC HQ as part of their participation in a specific GWC-Led Service (to learn more about GWC-Led Services, click [here](#)). GWC-Led Service Users and GWC-Led Services Minor Users can have their own account to independently access and complete the Girls Who Code Curriculum activities, including submitting [Answers](#) to curriculum prompts and sharing projects in the Project Gallery, and may add an avatar and short biography. GWC-Led Service Users and GWC-Led Services Minor Users can view and edit their information on the program information page.

As part of some GWC-Led Services, either [GWC Personnel](#) or GWC-Led Service Users in leadership roles for a GWC-Led Services ("[Program Volunteers](#)") (such as College Loops) may also have access to certain GWC-Led Service Users and GWC-Led Service Minor Users information through [Member Pages](#) or [Progress Pages](#) so they can track independent progress through the curriculum resources on the Progress page, review and provide feedback on any Answers submitted by user in their GWC-Led Services, view submissions to the Project Gallery, explore other projects in the Project Gallery, interact with users in their GWC-Led Services by posting messages and replies using text or images to the users' message board using the Messages feature, create or coordinate an event on the Calendar, create digital Certificates of completion, or view users IDE projects and progress. Announcements from Girls Who Code about additional Girls Who Code opportunities or public events are visible on the Home Page or Calendar.

The GWC-Led Services may also utilize Third Party providers (e.g. to perform the coding operations or host sessions) in connection with the GWC-Led Services ("[Third Party Platform Providers](#)").

WHAT INFORMATION DOES GWC COLLECT?

We collect two types of information about you: (1) information that you voluntarily provide us by using the GWC-Led Services (described below under "[Information You Provide to Us](#)") and (2) information collected automatically as result of your use of the [Services](#) (described below under "[Information We Collect Automatically](#)"). Both types of information may be collected for us through partners, vendors, and trusted organizations ("[Third Party Service Providers](#)") to process the information on our behalf in accordance with our instructions, Privacy Policy, and any other appropriate confidentiality and security requirements. We may also receive information about you from Third Party sources (as described below under "[Information Received from Third Party Sources](#)"). The types and amounts of information collected will vary depending on what type of [GWC-Led Service User](#) you are (e.g. [Program Applicant](#), [Program Participant](#), [Event Registrant](#), [Community Partner](#), [GWC Personnel](#) or [Focus Group/Survey Participant](#)) and how you use GWC. We have also created [this chart](#) with the detailed categories of Personal Information we collect from each [Third Party Service Provider](#), including a provider description, the business purpose for which the information was collected, and the specific data collected or processed.

GWC-Led Services are not directed to Children

The GWC-Led Services are not directed toward individuals under the age of thirteen (13) ("[Children](#)"), and we request that such individuals do not provide [Personal Information](#). Additionally, we do not knowingly collect (or knowingly allow any third party to collect) or maintain Personal Information from anyone under the age of 13. If we become aware that a child under 13 has provided us with Personal Information or that Personal Information has been collected from a child under 13, then we will delete this information from our files as quickly as possible. If you are the parent or legal guardian of a child under 13 who you believe has provided personal information to GWC, please send an email to GWC at privacy@girlswhocode.com or contact us as set forth in the "[How Can I Contact GWC with Questions](#)" section below to have that child's information deleted.

Basically,

GWC asks for some information directly from [GWC-Led Service Users](#) (such as account information), and also collects some information automatically (such as debugging logs when errors occur) in order to provide you with the best possible GWC experience. Please see [this chart](#) for the detailed categories of [Personal Information](#) we collect from each [Third Party Service Provider](#), including a provider description, the business purpose for which the information was collected, and the specific data collected or processed.

Information You Provide To Us

We ask for and collect the following categories of Personal Information about you when you use the GWC-Led Services. When we act as a [Controller](#), this information is necessary for the adequate performance of the contract between you and us, for our legitimate interest in being able to provide and improve the GWC-Led Services, and to allow us to comply with our legal obligations. Without it, we may not be able to provide you with all the requested services. Our use of the information set forth below is described in the section "How Does GWC Use the Information it Collects". There are currently six categories of [GWC-Led Service Users: Program Applicant, Program Participant, Event Registrant, Community Partner, GWC Personnel, or Focus Group/Survey Participant](#). Additionally, as a non-logged in visitor to the GWC Website, you may provide additional personal information as set forth in our separate [GWC Website Privacy Policy](#). For GWC-Led Service Users, we collect and store the following categories of information:

- **Account Sign-Up and Profile Information:**

In order to use certain GWC-Led Services that we offer via the GWC HQ platform, you may be required to create an account on GWC HQ ("[GWC HQ Account](#)") and provide certain registration information (such as first and last name, email address, passwords, and locations (among other information)). GWC-Led Service Users can also add a bio about themselves on certain GWC-Led Service products. Additionally, you may be required to create an account on a Third Party Platform Provider in order to utilize certain GWC-Led Services. These Third Party Platform Providers have their own privacy policies, and we encourage you to review them

before providing them with Personal Information. For instance, a Third Party Platform Provider's Privacy Policy may indicate that they may share your information back with us when you sign up for an account on their platform associated with a Girls Who Code activity (see [Information Received from Third Party Services](#) for more information). You may also choose to sign up through an [Authentication Service](#). We may link account registration and profile information with usage, participation, and technical data (such as login history, device or browser information, and engagement records) collected through the GWC-Led Services or received from our Third Party Service Providers and retain this information as part of a user's account record.

- **[Affiliation Information:](#)**

For some GWC-Led Services, GWC-Led Service Users may provide information regarding the organization, post-secondary program, or Community Partners with which they are affiliated.

- **[Demographic Information:](#)**

Depending on the Services or programs you choose to use, we may request or collect from GWC-Led Service User demographic data such as free or reduced lunch data, age, race or ethnicity, gender, first generation status, international status, household income, or language (among others), with your consent as required. This data is used in the aggregate for the purposes of supporting GWC programming, meeting reporting requirements for Grant Partners, and improving our GWC-Led Services. See [How Does GWC Use the Information it Collects](#) for more details.

- **[Messaging and other User Communications:](#)**

GWC may collect messages between GWC-Led Service Users and between GWC-Led Service Users and the staff, activity sponsors, and/or volunteers who are administering the GWC Services ("[GWC Personnel](#)"). Please be aware that by using any GWC messaging or communication features, including email requests, any message, photos, videos or other content shared can be viewed and possibly further shared (including outside of the GWC-Led Services) by all recipients.

- **[Calendar:](#)**

We collect information (e.g. event date, attendees) about GWC events that GWC-Led Service Users are invited to or attend.

- **[Virtual Events:](#)**

We collect information from GWC Event Registrants, Program Participants, Community Partners, and GWC Personnel regarding virtual events (using systems such as Zoom, etc., each a "[Virtual Event Tool](#)"). This information includes event attendance (through name, email, and unique meeting or webinar identifiers), information about the GWC experience of those GWC-Led Service Users, how long those attending stayed in the Virtual Event Tool (including join and leave times), and information generated through participation in the event, such as chat messages, Q&A submissions, poll responses, registration details, and related engagement data, as well as technical information (such as device type, operating system, and IP address) collected and reported by the Virtual Event Tool on behalf of GWC. The attendance data may also be shown to other designated third parties (either in the aggregate or with additional GWC-Led Services User consent) (e.g. Community Partners). Within Virtual Event Tool recordings, we collect (through downloading recordings and/or collecting reports from the

Virtual Event Tool on behalf of GWC) certain information through your participation in an event session, such as your image, voice, webinar ID, email, movements, and other audio information as well as chat logs or other information provided during the event. The virtual event sessions (including transcripts and chat logs) may be recorded from the perspective of all present GWC-Led Service Users to ensure the safety and quality of the virtual events for the GWC-Led Services. These recordings are deleted by the Virtual Event Tool depending on the Virtual Event Tool's policy (see [here](#) for more information). Separately, GWC may either download, store and retain the recordings (or elect to have the Virtual Event Tools retain these) to provide and maintain the service, conduct internal analysis, and keep our platform safe and secure. Additionally, for some recordings, GWC will keep a recording for the use of educational purposes. To learn more about these rules for Zoom in particular, read the [Zoom Retention Policy](#). Otherwise, please see the GWC [FAQ](#) on retention.

- **User-Generated Content:**

We collect content created by GWC-Led Service Users as part of participation in the GWC-Led Services, including message boards, answers to curricular questions, project galleries, IDE activities, contests, or in email.

- **Surveys and User Feedback:** Your responses to surveys, focus groups, or participation on panels, including tape recorded opportunities, that we, the GWC Research Team and/or research groups from partnering organizations or academic institutions ("[Research Partners](#)") might ask you to complete for research purposes and product improvement. These surveys and other user feedback and/or studies might ask you for your name and email as well as other free form and multiple-choice fields or questions. These surveys and other user feedback may be requested of all GWC-Led Service Users.

- **Conduct and Safety Information:** If a GWC-Led Service User reports another user on the GWC-Led Service (e.g. such as through a "report a message" button in the College Loops program) for conduct or safety issues, GWC collects the information provided in the report (e.g. the username, the content being reported, the reason for reporting) to investigate the report (e.g. assess and address offensive content), and to keep the platform safe and secure.

- **Contact Information and Correspondence with GWC:** As a GWC-Led Service User, you may choose to provide us with your Personal Information, such as your name, email address, mailing address, and telephone number, when asking a general question, communicating with customer support services, participating in a video testimonial about the GWC-Led Services, or choosing to participate in a feedback session or research effort. We collect records and copies of your correspondence (including email address and messages) when contacting us for support. When you send us a message using the "Contact Us" page or via email, the email address and phone numbers collected are not further used to market to the individual beyond providing the services requested or responding to the requests unless additional GWC-Led Services User consent is provided.

Basically,

We ask you for different types of information based on your GWC-Led Services User type and which GWC features you use (e.g., sending a message between GWC-Led Service Users) We have also prepared [this chart](#) of the [Personal Information](#) we collect and how we use it.

Information We Collect Automatically

When you use the GWC-Led Services, we (or our [Third Party Service Providers](#)) may use various technologies that automatically record or collect certain information, including Personal Information, from your browser or your device about the GWC-Led Services you use and how you use them. This information is necessary for the adequate performance of the contract between you and us, to enable us to comply with legal obligations and given our legitimate interest in being able to provide and improve the GWC-Led Services. For example, this could include the frequency and duration of your visits to GWC (similar to TV ratings that indicate how many people watched a particular show). If you use GWC on different devices, we may link the information we collect from those different devices to help us provide a consistent GWC-Led Service across your different devices. If we combine any automatically-collected information with Personal Information, we will treat the combined information as Personal Information, and it will be protected as per this Privacy Policy.

The technologies and information we automatically collect include:

- **Cookies and other similar technologies:** We (or our [Third Party Service Providers](#)) may use [cookies or similar technologies](#) to identify your browser or device. We (or our Third Party Service Providers) may also use these technologies in connection with advertising of our service that may appear on other sites or in connection with advertising their products outside of our GWC-Led Service (e.g., if you view an embedded YouTube video player on our GWC-Led Service, YouTube may place cookies or similar technologies on your browser when you play the video off our site). We don't allow these third-parties to advertise directly on our GWC-Led Service (i.e. such as when an advertiser would bid to place an advertisement directly on a platform such as Facebook), but we may serve [contextually relevant advertising](#) and, in limited circumstances, advertising or outreach that uses identifiers collected through tracking technologies in accordance with this Privacy Policy for Third Party products and services ourselves that we believe may be of interest to you (e.g., our Event Series). Please read our [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#) for more details, including how to modify your cookie settings and a list of the tracking technologies we use.
- **Advertising, Marketing, and Conversion Tracking Technologies:** We (or our Third Party Service Providers) may use advertising, marketing, and conversion tracking technologies, such as pixels, tags, or similar tools, on certain GWC-Led Services or program-related pages (including application or registration forms hosted by third-party platforms). These technologies help us

understand whether users take certain actions (such as viewing or submitting a form), measure the effectiveness of outreach efforts, and, where permitted, support retargeting or audience creation related to GWC programs. When these technologies are used, information such as online identifiers, cookie data, IP address, device and browser information, and interaction data (e.g., page views or form submissions) may be collected automatically. In some cases, limited personal information that you voluntarily provide through a form—such as your email address, phone number, or name—may be converted into a hashed or pseudonymous format by the third-party provider and used for conversion measurement, matching, or audience creation, consistent with the provider’s privacy practices. We do not permit third parties to display advertisements directly on the GWC-Led Services. Any use of advertising or marketing technologies is subject to applicable law and user choices, which may include consent or opt-out mechanisms described in our [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#).

- **Local storage:** We may also use, collect, and store information and preferences locally on your device using mechanisms such as browser-based web storage (including HTTP cookies and HTML5) and [application data caches](#).

Like many services, GWC (or our Third Party Service Providers) uses both local storage and cookies and other similar technologies to analyze trends, gather demographic information about our users, understand your engagement with the GWC-Led Services, administer the GWC-Led Services, tailor the GWC-Led Services for you, and to help the GWC-Led Services work better for you –for example, by remembering your language preferences or other information so that you will not have to re-enter it during the next time you visit the GWC-Led Services. - **Device information:** We collect device-specific information such as your device type, device brand, operating system, hardware version and settings, device settings, file and software names and types, battery and signal strength, and device identifiers (including unique device IDs). We may also collect device event information such as crashes, system activity, browser type, browser language, the date and time of your request and referral URL. This helps us measure how the GWC-Led Service is performing, improve GWC for you on your particular device, and send you push notifications if you’ve opted in to receive them.
- **Server log information:** Like most online services, when you use our GWC-Led Service we (or our Third Party Service Providers) automatically collect and store certain information in our or their [server logs](#). Examples include things like:
 - [IP address](#)
 - Details of how you used our GWC-Led Service, such as your activity on the GWC-Led Service (including product event data used to track progress or user activity), and the frequency and duration of your visits to the GWC-Led Service (similar to TV ratings that indicate how many people watched a particular show)
 - Telephone log information like your phone number and SMS routing information
 - Email log information
 - Data logs or activity needed for measuring up/down time and debugging tools

This information helps us make decisions about what we should work on next – for example, by showing which features are most (or least!) popular, and to send emails to encourage the GWC-Led Service User to finish an activity or start the next activity. We may use your IP Address and share it with third parties to help diagnose problems with our servers, for security purposes, to manage the Service, to enhance the GWC-Led Services based on usage pattern data and for analytics. We delete IP Addresses tracked in server logs after a specified period of time.

- **Location information:** When you use our GWC-Led Services, we may collect and process information about your geographic location, for example, based on your IP address. We collect both coarse (i.e., city-level) location data and precise location data. If we request precise geolocation information (“precise” meaning sufficient to identify street name and name of city or town) from you (such as when you are searching for a geographically local GWC activity), we ask for your permission. From all GWC-Led Service Users, if they upload photos or videos from their computer directly, we collect what the device sends us. If the device sends us Exchangeable Image File Format (EXIF data) (metadata contained within the image file --e.g. camera model, lighting conditions, and location (if enabled)) this can contain location data (and may contain precise location data). We strip all EXIF data, including the location information, from the photo before it is viewed by other users (e.g., the person receiving a message).

We do not continuously track precise device location, and we do not collect or use precise geolocation information beyond what is necessary for the specific purpose for which it was provided. Your choices regarding location-based data collection and other tracking technologies may vary depending on your jurisdiction and are managed through our consent and preference tools, where available. For more information about your choices and how to manage them, please see our [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#).

- **Cross-device collection:** To provide GWC-Led Service Users with a seamless online experience, we may link your identifiers on different browsers and environments you are using. We may also work with Third Party Service Providers to employ technologies, including the application of statistical modeling tools, which permit us to recognize and contact you across multiple devices.
- **Product events:** As users interact with the product, we collect product events about how the product is being used (e.g., which pages are viewed, which features are used, which buttons are clicked, load time, etc.). These are collected to provide the GWC-Led Services, including for internal analysis on product usage and quality. We may also use it to track progress in the GWC-Led Services, and for sending push or email notifications to GWC-Led Service User’s device to encourage them to take certain actions in the GWC GWC-Led Service. Our product event logs may also include unique device IDs and [IP addresses](#). We automatically delete IP Addresses tracked in product logs after six months.

Basically,

We collect some information from you automatically (and additionally use [Cookies](#) and other similar technologies to collect information) so that we know when things go wrong, or to help us

understand what parts of GWC need some improvement. If we need to request street-level (“precise”) geolocation data from you, we’ll ask for your explicit, opt-in consent. We never request precise geolocation data from minors under 18.

Information Received from Third Party Sources

We may also obtain information, including [Personal Information](#), from Third Party Service Providers and/or Research Partners, to update or supplement the information you provided or we collected automatically. This may include aggregated anonymous information or certain Personal Information that may be provided to us (e.g. survey information or information about your location to offer opportunities in geographic areas near you). If we receive Personal Information from [third-parties](#), we will handle it in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If we directly combine information we receive from other third-parties with Personal Information that we collect through the GWC-Led Services, we will treat the combined information as Personal Information and handle it in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Additionally, we may use any aggregated anonymous information received by third-parties as set forth below under the heading “[Aggregated Information and Non-Identifying Information](#)”. Local law may require you to authorize the Third Party to share your information with us before we can acquire it. We do not control, supervise, or respond to how third parties providing your information process your Personal Information, and any information request regarding the disclosure of your Personal Information to us should be directed to such third-parties. Please see [this chart](#) including a provider description, the business purpose for which the information was collected, and the specific data collected or processed.

Basically,

We may collect some information from Third Party sources when we send questionnaires. That information will be handled under this Privacy Policy. Please see [this chart](#) with the detailed categories of [Personal Information](#) including a provider description, the business purpose for which the information was collected, and the specific data collected or processed.

HOW DOES GWC USE THE INFORMATION IT COLLECTS?

First and foremost, you should know that GWC does not [sell](#) or rent your [Personal Information](#) to any Third Party for monetary consideration. We also do not allow third parties to display advertising within areas of GWC HQ that require you to log in. [Third Party Advertising](#) is not permitted on GWC HQ areas where users are required to log in, and Personal Information collected from GWC-Led Service Users between the ages of 13 and 17 (“[GWC-Led Service Minor Users](#)”) is not used for general commercial advertising. However, to support GWC programs and outreach, we may use limited third-party technologies (such as pixels) to help remind certain users about a program or an application they chose to start but did not complete (for example, by showing a reminder to return and finish an application). We do not permit third parties to use information collected through GWC-Led Services for their own independent advertising purposes. Where required by law, we provide choices (including opt-in or opt-out, as applicable) for these practices. We may serve [Contextually Relevant Advertising](#) for mission-aligned opportunities (such as internships or educational programs),

subject to applicable law and the choices described below, either for our own products (e.g. GWC Challenges) or relevant Third Party products and services that we believe may be of interest to you (e.g., internship opportunities). GWC commits that its collection, use, retention and sharing of Personal Information shall be reasonably necessary and proportionate to achieve the purposes for which the Personal Information was collected or processed and for the purposes disclosed in this Privacy Policy and [Third Party Service Providers Chart](#) and that the Personal Information will not be further processed in a manner incompatible with these purposes.

We use your Personal Information only when we have a valid legal basis to do so. More specifically, the information collected from GWC-Led Service Users is used for the following purposes:

- **Power Our GWC-Led Services:** This includes, operating, providing, enhancing and improving the GWC-Led Services, for example, by developing new products and features, and personalizing or customizing the GWC-Led Services for you.
- **Provide Internal Analytics and Reviews:** This includes using for internal audits and review, for analyzing how the GWC-Led Services are used, providing statistics about the usage levels of the GWC-Led Services, and diagnosing service or technical problems.
- **Process Your Transactions:** To fulfill your requests and provide any information you request, such as responding to your emails, submissions, contests, questions, comments, requests for information or customer support or for event registration, scheduling, or attendance; for any other purpose for which the information was collected (event registration, donations), or for which you provide your consent (if required).
- **Communicate with You:** To send you information about features on our GWC-Led Services or changes to our policies and GWC-Led Services or communicate with you about your use of the GWC-Led Services, your account, or transactions with us. We may also send you security alerts, and support and administrative messages and otherwise facilitate your use of, and our administration and operation of the GWC-Led Services (including notifying you of data privacy incidents). Personal Information is never shared with third parties in connection with this unless you have opted-in. - **Request Your Participation in Surveys or Focus Groups:** To request your participation in ratings, reviews, surveys, feedback sessions, focus groups, or other initiatives, coordinated by either GWC or a trusted Community Partner (such as a Research Partner), which help GWC and/or a Community Partner gather information used to assess, develop and enhance our products and GWC-Led Services.
- **Program reporting and funders.** We may use information we collect to monitor, evaluate, and report on our programs. In some cases we share program-level data with our Grant Partners to meet reporting requirements or to support program evaluation. For some GWC-Led Services, if a GWC-Led Service User provides their [Affiliation Information](#) associating them with a Community Partner, we may provide the GWC-Led Service Users name and participation data to that Community Partner.

- **Third Party Communications or Promotions:** We may share Personal Information about you with third parties to allow them to contact you regarding products, programs, services and promotions that they believe may interest you. In the case of promotions, you should carefully review the rules, if any, of each promotion in which you participate through the Sites, as such rules may contain additional important information about a sponsor's or other party's use of Personal Information about you. - **Parental Request for Information.** If you are under 18 years of age, we may provide your Personal Information to your parent or guardian only in accordance with applicable law or with your explicit consent. If Personal Information is shared in accordance with the above, we may pass along the Personal Information to third parties only as directed.
- **Security and Fraud Prevention:** Most crucially, to protect our community by making sure the GWC-Led Service remains safe and secure, such as by detecting, investigating and preventing activities that may violate our policies or be illegal.
- **Comply with Law:** To comply with applicable law – for example, to satisfy tax or reporting obligations, or to comply with a lawful governmental request or notify you of data privacy incidents when legally required.

We use automatically collected information (described in the "[Information We Collect Automatically](#)" section above) to provide and support our GWC-Led Service, and for the additional uses described in this section of this Privacy Policy. To learn more about how we use your information for personalization and tracking, please see the [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#).

When acting as a [Controller](#), we process this information given our legitimate interest in improving and protecting the [GWC-Led Service](#) and our GWC-Led Service Users' experience with it, taking into consideration your interests, rights, and expectations. Depending on the circumstances, we may also rely on your consent or the fact that the processing is necessary for the adequate performance of the contract with you, to protect your vital interest or those of other persons or the GWC-Led Service, and to comply with applicable laws.

Additionally, when acting as a [Controller](#), we will process your [Personal Information](#) for the purposes listed in this section related to marketing given our legitimate interests in undertaking marketing activities to offer you products and GWC-Led Services that may be of your interest. You can opt-out of receiving marketing communications from us at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions included in our marketing communications.

Please note that we may anonymize and/or [De-identify](#) information collected through the GWC-Led Services or via other means so that the information no longer relates to you. Subject to applicable laws, where we have anonymized and/or [De-identified](#) information so that it no longer identifies you personally, our use and disclosure of such information is not subject to this Privacy Policy.

Automated Decision Making & AI Use

We use [artificial intelligence \(“AI”\)](#) , [AI Processing](#), and other [Automated Tools](#) (such as algorithms) (together, the “[AI Tools](#)”) to support and improve our internal operations, protect the security of our services, and enhance your overall experience. These AI Tools help us organize information, review content, identify potential technical or safety issues, and streamline certain administrative tasks. We do not use AI or Automated Tools for profiling or to otherwise make any decision based solely on automated processing that would significantly affect you without the opportunity for human review (“[Automated Decision Making](#)”). These Automated Tools are designed to assist our staff – not to replace human judgment. AI Tools are used only for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy.

Girls Who Code staff may use AI Tools that process some of the same categories of personal information you provide to us or that we collect through your interactions with the GWC-Led Services for internal operations, to protect the security of our services, and enhance your overall experience including but not limited to administrative drafting, internal documentation, or improving written communications. We limit the use of personal information to what is necessary for the specific tasks the AI Tools support, and we apply data-minimization and user based access controls to protect your privacy.

We do not knowingly use your personal information to train external artificial intelligence (AI) models, unless we have clearly informed you and obtained your consent when required by applicable law. Our Third Party Service Providers may offer AI-enabled functionality as part of the services they perform on our behalf. In those cases, they may process personal information only in accordance with our instructions and solely for our operational purposes. We do not knowingly permit our service providers to use personal information for their own AI training or for any other independent purposes. For more information about these service providers and their roles, please see our [Third-Party Service Provider Chart](#).

If you have questions about how AI Tools process your information, or if you want to exercise your privacy rights—including the right to [access, correct, delete, or object to the use of your personal information in connection with AI Tools](#) —you may contact us at privacy@girlswhocode.com, or at any time using the information provided in this Privacy Policy.

Basically,

GWC doesn't [Sell](#) or rent your information to third-parties, we don't permit [Third Party advertising](#) on the [GWC-Led Services](#), and [Personal Information](#) collected from [GWC-Led Service Minor Users](#) is never used for [Behaviorally-targeted advertising](#) to GWC-Led Service Minor Users. We use your information to provide and personalize the GWC-Led Services to you, optimize and improve our GWC-Led Services, communicate with you about our GWC-Led Services, and for security and safety reasons. We may also use the information provided by GWC-Led Service Users to provide information about events, announcements, offers, promotions, products, including Third Party products, and GWC Services we think will be of interest to you. Additionally, we may use [AI](#) Tools to help us organize information, review content, identify potential technical or safety issues, and streamline certain administrative tasks. We do not knowingly use your personal information to train external artificial intelligence (AI) models, unless we have clearly informed you and obtained your consent when required by applicable law.

WILL GWC SHARE ANY INFORMATION IT COLLECTS?

GWC does not [Sell](#) or rent your [Personal Information](#) to any Third Party for any purpose - including for advertising or marketing purposes. GWC does not sell or rent your Personal Information for monetary consideration. [Third Party advertising](#) is not permitted on areas where GWC-Led Service Users are required to log in to [GWC HQ](#) and Personal Information collected in the GWC-Led Services are not used for general commercial advertising to minors. As described above, GWC may use limited outreach technologies (such as pixels) to remind users about GWC programs or applications they chose to begin but did not complete. Where required by law, we provide opt-in or opt-out choices for these practices. Furthermore, we do not disclose Personal Information with any third-parties except in the limited circumstances described in this Privacy Policy and as set forth below:

- **Other Users You Share and Communicate within GWC-Led Services:** No profiles of GWC-Led Service Users within [GWC HQ Accounts](#) are made available to the general public through our GWC-Led Service. Furthermore, GWC-Led Service Minor Users cannot share their account information, profile, projects, IDE activities, or answers to curricular questions with anyone on GWC HQ outside of other logged in GWC-Led Service Users and/or GWC Personnel.

Please keep in mind that information (including Personal Information) or content that you voluntarily disclose to others - including to other GWC users you interact with through the GWC-Led Services (such as messages you might send other GWC-Led Service Users or GWC Personnel you collaborate with) - can be viewed, copied, stored, and used by the people you share it with. We cannot control the actions of people with whom you choose to share information and we are not responsible for the collection, use, or disclosure of such information or content by others. We, therefore, encourage you only to post information that you are sure you want to be accessible to anyone.

- **Third Party Integrations on our GWC-Led Services:** When you as a GWC-Led Services User use Third Party apps, websites, or other services that use, or are integrated with, our [GWC-Led Service](#), they may receive information about what you post or share. Please see [here](#) for a list of Third Party app integrations on our GWC-Led Services.
- **Service providers:** We do work with vendors, GWC-Led Service [Third Party Service Providers](#), and other partners to help us provide the [GWC-Led Services](#) by performing tasks on our behalf. Additionally, these partners and service providers must adhere to confidentiality and security obligations in a way that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. - **Social Media Platforms:** Where permissible according to applicable law, we may share certain limited Personal Information with social media platforms (such as Google or Facebook) and

other websites, applications or partners, to generate leads, drive traffic to our websites or otherwise market and advertise our products or [GWC-Led Services](#) on those websites or applications (this will never include Personal Information of [GWC-Led Service Minor Users](#)). We may also share certain Personal Information with social media platforms and other websites to ensure that these individuals are not marketed to on these platforms. These processing activities, when we are acting as a [Controller](#) are based on our legitimate interest in undertaking marketing activities to offer you products and services that may be of your interest. These social media platforms with which we may share your [Personal Information](#) are not controlled or supervised by GWC. Therefore, any questions regarding how your social media platform processes your Personal Information should be directed to such provider. You may also choose to contact us here if you would like to opt-out of any such sharing. See the [Online Tracking Technologies Policy](#) for additional information.

- **Analytics Services:** We use analytics services, to help us understand and improve how the GWC-Led Service is being used. These services may collect, store and use information in order to help us understand things like how often you use the GWC-Led Service, the events that occur within the application, usage, performance data, and from where the application was downloaded. - **Program reporting and funders.** We may share program-level data with our funders and grant partners (“Grant Partners”) to meet reporting requirements or to support program evaluation. - **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose information, including [Personal Information](#), if we have a good faith belief that doing so is necessary to comply with the law, such as complying with a subpoena or other legal process. We may need to disclose Personal Information where, in good faith, we think it is necessary to protect the rights, property, or safety of GWC, our employees, our community, or others, or to prevent violations of our [Terms of Service](#) or other agreements. requests and defending ourselves against Third Party claims and allegations. Where appropriate, we may notify users about the legal requests, unless (i) providing notice is prohibited by the legal process itself, by court order we receive, or by applicable law; (ii) we believe that providing notice would be futile, ineffective, create a risk of injury or bodily harm to an individual or group, or create or increase a risk of fraud upon GWC, its users or the Direct Service. In instances where we comply with legal requests without notice for these reasons, we will attempt to notify that user about the request after the fact where appropriate and where we determine in good faith that we are no longer prevented from doing so.

- **Fraud and Security Protection:** We may share information to assist with security operations for scheduled penetration testing, auditing, and continuous improvement of our security practices, including without limitation, exchanging information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection. Authorized parties of the information would comply with our current privacy and security policies.
- **Sharing with GWC Companies:** Over time, GWC may grow and reorganize. We may share your Personal Information with affiliates such as a parent company, subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies that we control or that are under common control with us, in which case we will require those companies to agree to use your Personal Information in a way that is consistent with this Privacy Policy.
- **Change of control:** This Privacy Policy will continue to apply to your information in the event of a change of control, and any acquirer would only be able to handle your Personal Information as per this policy (unless you give consent to a new policy). We will provide you with notice of an acquisition within thirty (30) days following the completion of such a transaction, by posting on our homepage, or by email to your email address that you provided to us. If you do not consent to the use of your Personal Information by such a successor company, subject to applicable law, you may request its deletion from the company. We may also make information, including Personal Information, available to a potential investor or purchaser (or their advisors) in advance of any such transaction completion.

In the unlikely event that GWC goes out of business, or files for bankruptcy, we will protect your Personal Information, and will not sell it to any Third Party.

- **With your consent:** Other than the cases above, we won't disclose your Personal Information for any purpose unless you consent to it.

Basically,

GWC doesn't [sell](#) or rent your [Personal Information](#) to any third-parties. We believe your information is yours, and you should own it - we think that's the right way to operate. We share some information with [Third Party Service Providers](#) who help us provide you with the [GWC-Led Services](#) – like companies that help us send emails, for example, or if we have to comply with the law.

Additionally, you may choose to share information with other users of the GWC-Led Services or to third-parties that are integrated on our GWC-Led Services.

And, if GWC is ever acquired or goes out of business, our commitments don't change: we still won't [sell](#) or rent your [Personal Information](#) to anyone. Your Personal Information will continue to be protected by this policy, and any company that acquires GWC will have to abide by this policy unless you give consent to a new policy.

HOW DOES GWC PROTECT AND SECURE MY INFORMATION?

The security of your [Personal Information](#) is important to us. The safety and security of your Personal Information also depends on you and you should maintain good internet security practices. Where you have password-protected access to an account or certain parts of the GWC-Led Services, you are responsible for keeping this password secure at all times. You should not share your password with anyone. You must prevent unauthorized access to your account and Personal Information by selecting and protecting your password appropriately and limiting access to your computer or mobile device and browser by signing off after you have finished accessing your account. If you think that any of your accounts have been compromised you should change your account credentials with us. In particular make sure any compromised account can't access GWC. We will never email you to ask for your password or other account login information. If you receive such an email, please send it to us so we can investigate.

We work hard to protect our community, and we maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and physical security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of the [Personal Information](#) designed to protect Personal Information from unauthorized or illegal use, destruction, disclosure, or access.

Although we make concerted good faith efforts to maintain the security of Personal Information, and we work hard to ensure the integrity and security of our systems, no practices are 100% immune, and we can't guarantee the security of information. Outages, attacks, human error, system failure, unauthorized use, or other factors may compromise the security of user information at any time. If we learn of a security breach, we will attempt to notify you electronically (subject to any applicable laws and school reporting requirements) so that you can take appropriate protective steps; for example, we may post a notice on our homepage (www.girlswhocode.com) or elsewhere on the GWC-Led Service, and may send email to you at the email address you have provided to us. Depending on where you live, you may have a legal right to receive notice of a security breach in writing.

Basically,

The security of your information is important to us, and we take it very seriously. We're always adding safeguards to ensure the safety and security of GWC and our community of users. You can help us out by keeping your password secret! When you enter [Personal Information](#) anywhere on

the GWC-Led Service, we encrypt the transmission of that information using SSL by default. GWC's databases where we store your Personal Information are [encrypted at rest](#), which converts all Personal Information stored in the database to an unintelligible form. HOW LONG DOES GWC KEEP INFORMATION ABOUT ME?

We retain the data we collect for different periods of time depending on what it is, how we use it, and how you configure your settings.

You can read more about GWC's data retention periods, including how long it takes us to delete your information [here](#).

We store your [Personal Information](#) for as long as it is necessary to provide the GWC-Led Services to you and others, including those described above. We determine the appropriate retention period for Personal Information on the basis of the amount, nature and sensitivity of the Personal Information being processed, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of the Personal Information, whether we can achieve the purposes of the processing through other means, and on the basis of applicable legal requirements (such as applicable statutes of limitations). The time periods for which we retain your Personal Information depend on the purposes for which we use it. Personal information associated with your account will be kept until your account is deleted, unless we no longer need the data to provide products and services, in which case we will delete prior to you deleting your account.

You can, of course, [delete your account](#) at any time in accordance with relevant legal and compliance obligations. Please note that we may also have to retain some information after your account is deleted or closed, to comply with legal obligations, to protect the safety and security of our community or our GWC-Led Service, or to prevent abuse of our [Terms](#). Additional examples of when we may need to retain [Personal Information](#) after your account is deleted:
