FREE PROGRAMS WITH A BIG IMPACT

Our free programs prepare young people to thrive and lead in the tech workforce from early education onward.



Clubs are free, project-based computer science programs that build community and a culture of bravery for **3rd-12th graders at any skill level**.

Benefits include:

- Swag incentives and the Clubs Fund to purchase supplies and snacks for eligible Clubs.
- Live help and online training.
- Meeting templates, recruitment tools, and facilitation guides.
- Immersive events to engage and inspire participants.

Summer Programs invite **high school-age girls and non-binary students** of all skill levels to learn to code in live virtual classrooms or self-paced study.

Benefits include:

- Exclusive virtual events with industry-leading companies.
- Need-based grants and tech support for eligible students.
- Alumni programming and career support.
- A supportive sisterhood and lifelong friends.

College & Career Programs support success in computer science pathways for **women and non-binary individuals in college and early career**.

Benefits include:

- University- and college-level networks and community.
- Virtual talks exploring career paths and technical topics.
- Small-group mentoring from STEM professionals.
- Hiring summits to connect job-seekers with hiring partners.

OUR IMPACT

- **670,000** girls, women, and non-binary individuals served.
- **Over half** of the students served are from historically underrepresented groups.
- Alumni earn computer science and related degrees at **7x the national average**.
- **218,000 college- or post-college-age alumni** in 2024 – 4.7x the number of women graduating with CS-related degrees in the U.S.
